<p>Intent: To help current law students experiencing financial difficulties to continue their studies.</p> <p>Overview & Criteria: Merit and need based grants of up to \$1000 available to students currently enrolled in a U.S. or Canadian law school. (1L, 2L, or 3L).</p> <p>To apply: Submit one (1) sheet of paper listing your name, contact information, and, as applicable, your class rank (undergraduate and law school), LSAT score, extra-curricular activities, and a brief overview of your financial need. On the same sheet, include an essay of not more than 250 words describing why you are a deserving recipient of the award.</p>	<p>Intent: To help students wishing to attend law school to pay for law school applications fees, LSAT testing fees, and other related costs.</p> <p>Overview & Criteria: Merit and need based grant of up to \$1000 available awarded twice yearly to applicants who will apply to a U.S. or Canadian law school.</p> <p>To apply: Submit one (1) sheet of paper listing your name, contact information, and, if applicable, your class rank, extra-curricular activities, and a brief overview of your financial need. On the same sheet, include an essay of not more than 250 words describing why you are a deserving recipient of the award.</p>

Scholarships are awarded twice annually. Applications received after the deadline will be considered in the following award period.
