

A package delivery company makes exactly one delivery to each of the following six businesses—Alltech, Builtwell, Chalmer, DeLand, Elastomertech, and Fillimore—but not necessarily in that order. Each delivery is made to one business at a time, and the following conditions apply:

The delivery to Builtwell is made before the delivery to DeLand and after the delivery to Alltech.

The delivery to Chalmer is earlier than the delivery to Builtwell.

If the Alltech delivery is earlier than the Fillimore delivery, then the Elastomertech delivery is earlier than the DeLand delivery.

The Fillimore delivery is either earlier than the Chalmer delivery, or it is later than the DeLand delivery, but not both.
